

## BIRTHDAY HAT



### **Card Stock:**

Sahara Sand – 8-1/4" x 4-1/4"  
In Good Taste DSP – 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"  
In Good Taste DSP – 2-5/8" x 4-1/8"  
Early Espresso – 8-1/2" x 3-1/2" (score at 4-1/4")  
Sahara Sand – 4-1/8" x 3-3/8"  
Basic White – 4" x 3-1/4" (cut 2)  
Early Espresso – 3" x 4"  
Basic White scrap

### **Stamp Set(s):**

Hats Off  
Lighthearted Lines

### **Ink:**

Sahara Sand Stampin' Pad  
Early Espresso Stampin' Pad  
Tuxedo Black Memento Stamp Pad

### **Supplies/Accessories:**

Hat Builder Dies  
Rectangles Stitched Framelits  
Linen Thread  
Pebbles Enamel Shapes  
Stampin' Dimensionals

### **Instructions:**

1. Fold 11" x 4-1/4" to card size of 5-1/2" x 4-1/4". Cut right side of card front at 2-3/4". Attach In Good Taste 5-3/8" x 4-1/8" DSP to inside of card.
2. Attach Good Taste 2-5/8" x 4-1/8" DSP to card front (left side of course).
3. Score Early Espresso 8-1/2" x 3-1/2" at 4-1/4" and fold to 4-1/4" x 3-1/2". Attach to inside of card with the front of this piece folding in the opposite direction of the card as shown above.
4. Punch out both pieces of the Basic White 4" x 3-1/4" using the 2-5/8" x 3-7/8" rectangle die from the Rectangles Stitched Framelits. Attach one to inside of the Early Espresso and one to the Sahara Sand 4-1/8" x 3-3/8" card stock. Attach the second piece to the Early Espresso front.
5. Attach a length of the Linen Thread to the edge of the Early Espresso on card front as shown above, wrapping a couple times and tying off.
6. Stamp the Early Espresso 3" x 4" card stock using the large hat from the Hats Off stamp set and the Memento stamp pad. Punch out using the coordinating hat die from the Hat Builder Dies set. Attach to card front using dimensionals.
7. Stamp the "mountain" patch onto the Basic White scrap using Sahara Sand stamp pad. Punch out using the coordinating die from the Hat Builder Dies set. Attach to front of hat on card.
8. Attach Pebbles Enamel Shapes on card front randomly as shown above.
9. Stamp verse of choice from the Lighthearted Lines stamp set and the Early Espresso stamp pad to inside of card and you are now done!!
