



Card Stock:

Real Red – 8-3/4" x 7-1/2"
Basic Black – 8-3/8" x 3-3/8" (cut 2)
Basic White – 8-1/4" x 3-1/4" (cut 2)
Real Red Scrap
Basic Black Scrap
Adhesive Sheets

Stamp Sets:

Love Cats
Sweet Conversations

Ink:

Tuxedo Black Memento Stamp Pad
VersaMark Stamp Pad
Basic White Embossing Powder

Supplies/Accessories:

Alphabet a la Mode Dies
Cracker & Treat Box Dies
Adhesive Backed Studs
Mini Stampin' Dimensionals

Instructions:

1. Fold Real Red 8-3/4" x 7-1/2" card stock to card size of 8-3/4" x 3-3/4".
2. Attach an adhesive sheet (cut to size) to the Real Red Scrap. Next, cut out using the letters from the Alphabet a la Mode Dies set. Using a ruler, line up the letters evenly. Then, remove backing from the adhesive sheet as you attach the letters to card front. After you've attached the letters, stamp the cat from the Love Cats stamp set and the Memento stamp pad onto the right of the letters you've just attached. I used the Stamparatus to get a nice dark image.
3. From the Sweet Conversations stamp set, stamp just the "Valentine's Day" onto the Basic Black scrap using the VersaMark stamp pad. Heat emboss using the Basic White embossing powder. Cut out using a label from the Cracker & Treat Box Dies set. Attach to the right of the letters on card front using Mini Dimensionals.
4. Attach the Basic Black 8-3/8" x 3-3/8" card stock pieces to the front and inside of card.
5. Attach the finished Basic White 8-1/4" x 3-1/4" to card front.
6. Attach the 2nd Basic White 8-1/4" x 3-1/4" to the inside of the card.
7. Last, but not least, attach Adhesive Backed Studs to card front and you are now done!!
