 Tombow Liquid Glue

Instructions:

1. Fold Thick Basic White 7-1/2” x 8-3/4” card stock to card size of 3-3/4” x 8-3/4”.
2. Attach Dainty Flowers 3-1/2” x 8-1/2” DSP to card front.
3. Attach Mossy Meadow 2-3/4” x 7-3/4” card stock to card front.
4. Using Fresh Freesia stamp pad and small background stamp, stamp images randomly all over the Basic White 4-7/8” x 2-5/8” card stock. Attach evenly to the upper portion of the Mossy Meadow on card front, leaving about 1/16” around the 3 sides.
5. Emboss the Fresh Freesia 2-3/4” x 2-5/8” card stock using the Timeworn 3d embossing folder and embossing machine. Attach to card front butting the top to the Basic White on card front.
6. Punch out two vines using the vine die from the Queen Bee Dies set. Using the Tombow Liquid Glue, attach to upper portion of card as shown above.
7. Stamp flowers from the Queen Bee stamp set onto Basic White scraps using the Rich Razzleberry stamp pad. Color them in using the above listed blender pens or colors of your choice. Punch out flowers using the coordinating die from the Queen Bee Dies set. Attach to the vines using the Tombow Liquid Glue.
8. Stamp large bee from the Queen Bee stamp set onto another Basic White scrap using the Rich Razzleberry stamp pad. Punch bee out using the coordinating bee from the Queen Bees Dies set. Attach to card front as shown above using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
9. Attach a piece of the burlap ribbon from the Real Red & Burlap Ribbon Pack to card front, centering over the two attached pieces on front. Trim ends as shown above.
10. Stamp the happy and birthday from the Queen Bee stamp set onto another scrap of Basic White card stock using the Rich Razzleberry stamp pad. Punch out using label die from the Queen Bee Dies set. Attach over ribbon on card front using dimensionals.
11. Last, but not least, add Opal Rounds listed above. You are now done!!
