## Instructions:

1. Fold the Tea Boutique Card with the front inside the card. Then score and fold back the front at $2-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$. That way half the red (or other color) front is shown on the front and the other half is inside. Then attach the Tea Boutique 4-1/4" $\times 2-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ DSP to the right side of the inside of the card. This will actually show when the card is closed.
2. Punch out the Basic White $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ card stock using the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ scallop die from the Scalloped Contours Dies set. Then stamp the stems from the Cup of Tea stamp set onto this piece a bit toward to the top using the Granny Apple Green stamp pad. Next, stamp the flowers onto the stems using the Sweet Sorbet stamp pad. Put adhesive on only $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ of the back of this piece and attach to the card front, centering over the fold as shown above.
3. Using the VersaMark stamp pad, stamp cup image of choice from the Cup of Tea stamp set onto the Starry Sky scrap, then sprinkle the Basics White Embossing Powder over this image and heat emboss using heat tool. Punch out using coordinating die from the Cup of Tea Dies set. Next, punch a small oval from the Starry Sky scrap. Stamp the tiny leaf image from the Cup of Tea stamp set using VersaMark and heat emboss using the Basics White Embossing Powder. Attach to the bottom of the tea cup you just punched out to form the saucer. Next, stamp the tea bag image onto the Basic White scrap using the Sweet Sorbet stamp pad. Stamp the "Time for Tea" image in the center of the red using the Starry Sky stamp pad. Punch out using the coordinating tea bag die from the Cup of Tea dies. Using the Take Your Pick Tool, punch a little hole in the top of this. Put a little length of the Baker's Twine through the hole and put a piece of scotch tape on the back of the tea bag to hold the twine in place. Attach the other end of the twine to the top of the cup attaching it the back with scotch tape. Attach to card front using dimensionals as shown above.
4. Tie small bow from the $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Gold Trimmed Ribbon and attach to the cup using Mini Glue Dots. Attach the green rhinestones to the center of the two flowers. Attach a some Opaque Adhesive Backed Gems to the stems. Add a few Brushed Brass Butterflies to the side as shown above.
5. Stamp the "Let's Get Together Soon" image from the Cup of Tea to the inside of the card using the Starry Sky stamp pad. Stamp a couple flowers from the same stamp set using the Sweet Sorbet stamp pad. Attach a couple of the green rhinestones to the center of the flowers and you are now done!
