

## Blessings of Home



### Card Stock:

Blueberry Bushel – 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"  
Heart & Home DSP – 5-1/4" x 4"  
Blueberry Bushel – 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"  
Basic White – 3-1/8" x 3-1/8"  
Blueberry Bushel Scrap  
Basic White Scrap  
Basic White 5-1/4" x 4" (Inside)

### Stamp Set:

Blessings of Home

### Ink:

Blueberry Bushel Stampin' Pad  
VersaMark Stamp Pad  
Basic White Embossing Powder

### Supplies/Accessories:

Flowers of Home Dies  
Stylish Shapes Dies  
Timeworn Embossing Folder  
Night of Navy 3/8" Bordered Ribbon  
Adhesive Backed Milky Dots  
Stampin' Dimensionals  
Mini Glue Dots  
Tape or Post It Note for Masking

### Instructions:

1. Score & fold Blueberry Bushel at 4-1/4".
2. Attach Heart & Home 5-1/4" x 4" DSP to card front.
3. Using the Timeworn Embossing Folder, emboss the Basic White 3-1/8" x 3-1/8" card stock. Attach to the Blueberry Bushel 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" card stock. Attach to card front as shown above.
4. Stamp large flower from the Blessings of Home stamp set using the Blueberry Bushel Stampin' Pad, stamp image onto the Basic White scrap. Punch out using the coordinating die from the Flowers of Home Dies set and Stampin Cut & Emboss Machine. Attach to card front as shown above using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Tie a bow from the Night of Navy 3/8" Bordered Ribbon and attach to flower image using a Mini Glue Dot.
6. Attach several Adhesive Back Milky Dots to card front as shown above.
7. Mask the stamp "Beautiful Day" so that only the two words are showing. Ink up with the VersaMark stamp pad, remove tape and stamp image onto the Blueberry Bushel Scrap. Heat emboss using the Basic White Embossing Powder. Punch out using the 3" x 1" label from the Stylish Shapes Dies. Cut one end off and attach to card front using dimensionals.
8. Dry emboss about 1/4 of the left side of the Basic White 5-1/4" x 4" card stock using the Timeworn Embossing Folder and Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
9. Using the large flower stamp from the Blessings of Home stamp set and Blueberry Bushel stamp pad (stamp off the image at least 3 times) stamp image onto the center of the card stock as shown above. Attach to inside of card and you are now done!
