Card Stock:

Thick Basic White – 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Calypso Coral or Lemon Lolly – 2-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Pool Party or Garden Green – 2-1/8" x 5-1/2"

Inked Botanicals or Fresh as a Daisy $-\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" (cut 12)

Basic White Scraps

Calypso Coral Scrap

Lemon Lolly Scraps

Adhesive Sheet Scrap

Garden Green Scraps

Granny Apple Green Scraps

Copper Clay Scrap

Supplies/Accessories:

Cheerful Daisies Dies

Wanted to Say Dies

Tinsel Gems Three-Pack

Calypso Coral 3/8" Satin Ribbon

Sheer Ribbon Combo (Azure Afternoon)

Mini Glue Dots

Stampin' Dimensionals

Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

Multipurpose Liquid Glue

Simply Scored Scoring Tool or Paper Trimmer

Instructions:

- 1. Score & fold Thick Basic White 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card stock at 4-1/4" to card size of 5-1/2" x 4-1/4"
- **2.** Score the Basic White $5-1/2" \times 2"$ on the long side in 1" increments. The last score line will only be about $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- **3.** Attach first $\frac{1}{2}$ " DSP design strips by starting at the top left corner and crossing down to the top of the score line to the right side. Do this with this design only until you reach the bottom of the card stock. Trim the edges even with the card stock and you'll need to do some extra trimming at the bottom.
- **4**. Attach the second $\frac{1}{2}$ " DSP design strips going in the opposite direction starting on the right side. Attach all strips until you reach the bottom of the card stock. Trim the sides and the bottom. Attach to the Pool Party or Garden Green 2-1/8" x 5-1/2" card stock. Then attach to the Calypso coral or Lemon Lolly 2-1/4" x 5-1/2" card stock. Attach to left side of card front as shown above.
- **5**. Using either the Wanted to Say Dies or Cheerful Daisies Dies and Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, punch out and attach to the right of the Double Twisted Ribbon piece.
- 6. Tie a bow in either the Azure Afternoon or Calypso Coral ribbons and attach to card front using Mini Glue Dots.
- 7. Attach Tinsel Gems randomly to card front and you are now done!!
