

Card Stock:

Highland Heather – 11" x 4-1/4"

Basic White – 5-1/4" x 4" (Cut 2)

Highland Heather – 4-3/4" x 3-1/2"

Perennial Lavendar DSP – 4-1/4" x 3"

Basic White Scrap

Soft Shimmer DSP Scrap

Adhesive Sheets Scrap

Perennial Lavendar DSP – 4" x ½" (Inside)

Stamp Set:

Perennial Postage

Pretty Peacock Stampin' Pad

Supplies/Accessories:

Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder Perennial Postage Dies Wanted to Say Dies Pretty Peacock Foiled Gems Stampin' Dimensionals Multipurpose Liquid Glue Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

Instructions:

- 1. Score and fold Highland Heather 11" x 4-1/4" card stock at 5-1/2" to form card size of 5-1/2" x 4-1/4".
- **2**. Emboss Basic White 5-1/4" x 4" card stock using the Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder and Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine. Attach to card front.
- **3.** Cut out the Highland Heather 4-3/4" x 3-1/2" card stock using the second largest postage frame from the Perennial Postage Dies set. Attach the Perennial Lavendar 4-1/4" x 3" DSP to this frame. Attach to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- **4.** Punch out the base of the word "celebrate" from the Basic White scrap using the die from the Wanted to Say Dies set. Attach a piece of the Adhesive Sheet to the Soft Shimmer DSP scrap. Cut out the word "celebrate" from the same die set. Peel off backing and attach to the word base. Attach to card front using liquid glue.
- **5**. Attach several Pretty Peacock foiled gems (from the Petal Pink & Pretty Peacock Foiled Gems) randomly to card front.
- **6**. Stamp verse from the Perennial Postage onto the Basic White $5-1/4" \times 4"$ using the Pretty Peacock stamp pad. Attach the Perennial Lavendar $4" \times 1/2"$ DSP to bottom of this piece. Attach inside of card and you are now done!!
