

Easter Egg Flowers



Card Stock:

Bubble Bath 11" x 4-1/4"
 Granny Apple Green – 5-1/2" x 4-1/4"
 Basic White – 3-3/8" x 4-5/8"
 Very Vanilla – 3-1/4" x 3-3/4"
 Basic White Thick – 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
 (or Watercolor Paper)
 Granny Apple Green – 5-1/4" x 4" (Inside)
 Basic White – 5-1/8" x 3-7/8" (Inside)

Ink:

Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Pad
 Melon Mambo Stampin' Pad
 Azure Afternoon Stampin' Pad
 Daffodill Delight Stampin' Pad
 Pecan Pie Stampin' Pad

Instructions:

1. Score and fold the Bubble Bath 11" x 4-1/4" card stock at 5-1/2" to form card size of 5-1/2" x 4-1/4".
2. Cut out the Granny Apple Green 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card stock using the largest die from the Perennial Postage Dies set.
3. Using the Pecan Pie stamp pad, stamp the Happy Easter verse from the Excellent Eggs stamp set onto the bottom center of the Basic White 3-3/8" x 4-5/8". Attach this to the Granny Apple Green you cut out from step 2. Attach this piece to the card front using dimensionals.
4. Using flower dies and the small butterfly from the Meadow Dies set, cut out from the Basic White Thick 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" card stock. Once you've cut out, lay the cut pieces back into the card stock to complete the next step. Be sure you have a piece of paper underneath.
5. Lay out two acrylic stamping blocks (size E works well). Next, stamp the corners of each block using a different stamp pad color listed above (or colors of your choice). Using the Water Painter, dip into the first color of choice and color in the flowers you've cut out. Wipe off the painter in between each color and continue until all the flowers are colored in. This will create a watercolor effect, so uneven colors are the best. Set aside to dry until the next step.
6. Cut out the Very Vanilla 3-1/4" x 3-3/4" card stock using the largest egg die from the Excellent Eggs dies set (or oval die). Then emboss using the Tasteful Textures 3D Embossing Folder. Using the sponge dauber, sponge the edge of the egg using the Daffodil Delight. Then attach the flowers (not the butterfly yet) using the liquid glue. The flowers will hang over. Once you've attached them, trim the edges even with the egg. Attach to card front above the "Happy Easter" using dimensionals as shown above.
7. Attach the butterfly using Mini Dimensionals.
8. Tie a bow, or double bow, using the Simply Elegant Trim. Attach to the egg on card front using mini glue dots as shown above.
9. Randomly attach Tinsel Gems to card front.
10. Stamp verse from the Timeless Tulips using the Pecan Pie stamp pad onto the Basic White 5-1/8" x 3-7/8" card stock. Stamp the bunny from the Excellent Eggs stamp set onto bottom corner of this piece using the same stamp pad, if desired. Attach to the Granny Apply Green 5-1/4" x 4" card stock. Attach to inside of card and you are now done!!!
