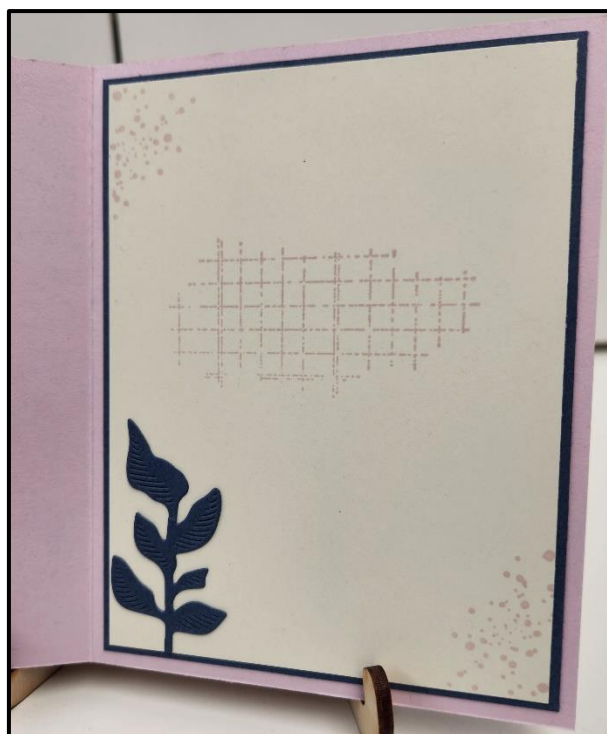


Notes of Nature



Card Stock:

Bubble Bath – 5-1/2” x 8-1/2”
Misty Moonlight – 5-1/4” x 4” (Cut 2)
Delightfully Eclectic DSP – 5-1/8” x 3-7/8”
Very Vanilla – 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” (Inside)
Bubble Bath – 4” x 2-1/2”
Bubble Bath Scraps
Misty Moonlight Scraps

Stamp Set:

Notes of Nature

Ink:

Misty Moonlight Stampin’ Pad
Bubble Bath Stampin’ Pad

Supplies/Accessories:

Notes of Nature Dies
Everyday Details Dies
Sheer Ribbon Combo – Bubble Bath
Tinsel Gems Three Pack
Stampin’ Dimensionals
Multipurpose Liquid Glue
Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine

Instructions:

1. Score and fold Bubble Bath 5-1/2” x 8-1/2” card stock at 4-1/4” to form card size of 5-1/2” x 4-1/4”.
2. Attach one Misty Moonlight 5-1/4” x 4” card stock to card front and one inside of card.
3. Attach Delightfully Eclectic 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” DSP to card front.
4. Using stem dies from the Notes of Nature Dies set and Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine cut out two small and the one long stem from the Misty Moonlight scraps. Using liquid glue, attach smallest stem to upper right corner of card front as shown above.
5. Stamp the Bubble Bath 4” x 2-1/2” card stock with the Field Notes from the Notes of Nature stamp set using the Misty Moonlight stamp pad. Cut out using the 2-5/8” x 4-1/8” label from the Everyday Details Dies set. Attach a small piece of Bubble Bath ribbon to the upper left of the label and attach to card front. Next, attach the long stem (you’ll need to cut down) and small stem to card front using liquid glue.
6. Stamp verse from the Notes of Nature stamp set onto a Bubble Bath scrap using the Misty Moonlight stamp pad. Cut out using the smallest label from the Everyday Details Dies and attach to card front using dimensionals.
7. Randomly attach Tinsel Gems to card front.
8. Stamp images from the Notes of Nature stamp set onto the Very Vanilla 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” card stock using the Bubble Bath stamp pad as shown above. Then attach the long stem piece you cut off for the front of the card using liquid glue. Attach to inside of card and you are now done!!
