
Swallowtail







Card Stock:

Thick Basic White – 11" x 4-1/4" Azure Afternoon – 5-7/16" x 4-1/4" Azure Afternoon – 5-1/4" x 4" (Inside) Basic White – 5-1/8" x 3-7/8" (Inside)

Stamp set:

Swallowtail

Ink:

Azure Afternoon Stampin' Pad

Supplies/Accessories:

Thoughtful Moments Hybrid Embossing Folder & Dies Fluttering Embossing Folder Rainbow Adhesive Backed Dots Stampin' Dimensionals Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

Instructions:

- 1. Do NOT score or fold the Thick Basic White 11" x 4-1/4" card stock. The first step is to stamp the Swallowtail onto the back of the card stock (what will be the back that is) using the Azure Afternoon stamp pad. Part of the Swallowtail will be on the back of the card, but the majority on the front. After you've stamped the Swallowtail, then score and fold the card at 5-1/2" to form the card size of 5-1/2" x 4-1/4". Next, using a pair of scissors, cut around the Swallowtail on card front, just the very edge.
- 2. Emboss the Azure Afternoon 5-7/16" x 4-1/4" card stock using the Fluttering Embossing Folder and Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine. Attach to the card front, behind the butterfly, ensuring the top and bottom edges are even.
- 3. Using the Azure Afternoon stamp pad, lightly ink the words you'd like on the Thoughtful Moments Embossing Folder. Then lay on the coordinating die over the words and cut out using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine. Pop up the words on card front using dimensionals.
- 4. Attach some Rainbow Adhesive Backed Dots on card front.
- **5**. Attach the Azure Afternoon 5-1/4" x 4" to inside of card.
- **6**. Using the Fluttering embossing folder, emboss one side of the Basic White 5-1/8" x 3-7/8" card stock. Then attach to inside of card and you are now done!!
