

## Painted Lavender



### Card Stock:

Crumb Cake – 4-1/4” x 11” (Cut 2)  
 Basic White – 5-3/8” x 4-1/8” (Cut 2)  
 Perennial Lavender DSP – 5-1/4” x 4” (Cut 2)  
 Lost Lagoon – 5-3/8” x 4-1/8” (Inside, Cut 2)  
 Basic White – 5-1/4” x 4” (Inside, Cut 2)  
 Perennial Lavender DSP – 4” x 3/4” (Inside, Cut 2)  
 Basic White Scraps  
 Gorgeous Grape Scraps  
 Highland Heather Scraps  
 Lost Lagoon Scraps  
 Pretty Peacock Scraps

### Stamp Set:

Dainty Delight

### Supplies/Accessories:

Painted Lavender Dies  
 Everyday Details Dies  
 Purple Fine Shimmer Gems  
 Linen Thread  
 Mini Glue Dots  
 Stampin’ Dimensionals  
 Multipurpose Liquid Glue  
 Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine  
 Paper Trimmer  
 Pencil  
 Ruler

### Instructions:

1. Score and fold both 11” x 4-1/4” card bases at 5-1/2”.
2. To both card front bases, attach Basic White 5-3/8” x 4-1/8” card stock.
3. For both DSPs, using a pencil and a ruler make small tick marks at 1/2” on the left side of the Perennial Lavendar 5-1/4” x 4”. Next, make a second tick mark 1/4” down from the 1/2” tick mark on the left side.
4. On the right side of the Perennial Lavendar from Step 3, measure down 3” and make another tick mark.
5. On the bottom of the Perennial Lavendar from Step 3, measure from left to right at 3” and make another tick mark.
6. Using a Paper Trimmer, cut from the 1/2” tick on the left side to the 3” tick on the right side. Next, cut from the 1/4” to the 3” tick on the bottom of the Perennial Lavendar. This will give you 3 sections. The middle section you will use on the 2<sup>nd</sup> card base and the middle from that card will be used on this card to give you an alternate pattern for each.
7. This is optional, but I wanted a little contrast on the diagonal sections of the DSP. So, I cut two 1/4” x 6-1/2” Basic White strips for each card. I then glued them to the diagonal edges as shown above. You’ll then trim the edges of the Basic White.
8. Attach the DSP center piece to the card front lining up so that about 1/8” of the Basic White on card front shows. Next, attach the other two DSP pieces as shown above.
9. For each card using the Painted Lavendar Dies, cut out foliage from the Gorgeous Grape, Highland Heather, Lost Lagoon and Pretty Peacock scraps. Attach to the top of the card at the “V” using liquid glue.
10. Tie a double bow from the Linen Thread and attach at the base of the foliage using a mini glue dot.
11. Stamp verse of choice from the Dainty Delight stamp set using the Gorgeous Grape stamp pad onto a Basic White scrap. Cut out using a label from the Everyday Details Dies set. You may need to cut twice depending on the length of your verse. Attach to card front using dimensionals.
12. Randomly attach Purple Fine Shimmer Gems to card front.
13. To both cards, attach the Lost Lagoon 5-3/8” x 4-1/8” card stock to inside.
14. Attach both the Perennial Lavendar 4” x 3/4” DSPs to both the Basic White 5-1/4” x 4” card stock pieces. Stamp verse of choice to the Basic White using Gorgeous Grape stamp pad. Attach to inside of both cards. You are now done and you’ve got 2 cards!!
