

## Timeless Tulips



### **Card Stock:**

Granny Apple Green – 5-1/2” x 8-1/2”  
 Flirty Flamingo – 5-1/4” x 4” (Cut 2)  
 Lily Impressions DSP – 5-1/8” x 3-7/8”  
 Basic White – 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” (Inside)  
 Basic White Scraps

### **Supplies/Accessories:**

Everyday Details Dies  
 Nested Essentials Dies  
 Tulip Builder Punch  
 3/8” Ribbon (Windowpane Evening Evergreen)  
 Pecan Pie & Clear Ribbonded Adhesive-Backed Dots  
 Stampin’ Dimensionals  
 Stampin’ Mini Glue Dots

Multipurpose Liquid Glue  
 Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine  
 Stampin’ Daubers or sponge

### **Ink:**

Pretty Peacock Stampin’ Pad  
 Granny Apple Green Stampin’ Pad  
 Peach Pie Stampin’ Pad  
 Melon Mambo Stampin’ Pad  
 Watercolor Pencils

### **Stamp Sets:**

Timeless Tulips  
 Simply Said

### **Instructions:**

1. Score and fold Granny Apple Green 5-1/2” x 8-1/2” at 4-1/4”.
2. Attach Flirty Flamingo to card front and one to inside of card.
3. Using the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest circle die from the Everyday Details Dies set, cut a circle from the upper center part of the Lily Impressions 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” DSP. Once punched, attach the 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” DSP to card front. Save the punched circle for the inside of the card.
4. Using the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest circle from the Everyday Details Dies set, cut out circle from the Basic White 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” (for inside) toward the top center of this piece. Attach this Basic White circle to the punched circle on card front as shown above.
5. Ink up the tulip stamp using the Peach Pie stamp pad and then using a sponge dauber, sponge the Melon Mambo around the edge of the tulip and stamp image onto a Basic White scrap. Do this twice. Then using a yellow color pencil from the Watercolor Pencils set, lightly color around the tulip edge at the center of the tulips. Punch out using the coordinating Tulip Builder Punch. Set aside until next step.
6. Ink up a stem from the Timeless Tulips stamp set using the Granny Apple Green, then using the same method from step 5, dauber some Pretty Peacock along the edge. Then stamp onto a Basic White scrap. Do this for another stem and three leaves. Fussy cut the stems out and punch out the leaves using the Tulip Builder Punch. Attach a stem to one tulip from step 5 using liquid glue. Then attach the leaves to the stems. Attach the tulip with stem using liquid glue to card front. The stem may be too long so just trim it off. Then attach the second stem using liquid glue. Attach the second tulip to the top of the 2<sup>nd</sup> stem using dimensionals.
7. Tie a bow from the 3/8” Ribbon and attach to card front using mini glue dots.
8. Stamp the hello from the Timeless Tulips stamp set onto a Basic White scrap using the Pretty Peacock stamp pad. Punch out using the smallest die from the Nested Essentials Dies set. Attach to card front just under the bow as shown above.
9. Randomly attach Clear Ribbonded Adhesive-Backed Dots to card front.
10. Attach the Basic White 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” card stock that you cut the circle from in step 4 to the inside of the card.
11. Attach circle you cut out from Step 3 to the inside of the card as shown above.
12. Using the 2<sup>nd</sup> smallest circle from the Everyday Details Dies set, punch a circle from another Basic White scrap. Stamp a verse onto the circle using Pretty Peacock. Attach to circle inside of card. You are now done!!
