Card Stock:

Azure Afternoon – 5-1/2” x 8-1/2”
 Basic White – 5-1/4” x 4”
 Snowflake Splendor DSP – 5-1/8” x 3-7/8”
 Basic White – 5-1/4” x 8” (Inside)
 Snowflake Splendor DSP – 5-3/8” x 1-7/8” (Cut 2, Inside)
 White Glimmer Paper – 2-1/2” x 2-1/2” (Die Cut Snowflake)
 Azure Afternoon – 2-1/2” x 2-1/2” (Die Cut Circle)
 Azure Afternoon – 2-1/2” x 2-1/2” (Die Cut Circle)
 Basic White – 2-1/2” x 1” (Die Cut Label)

Instructions:

1. Score and fold Azure Afternoon 5-1/2” x 8-1/2” card stock at 4-1/4”.
2. Attach Basic White 5-1/4” x 4” card stock to front of card base.
3. Attach Snowflake Splendor 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” DSP to card front. Using the 2-5/8” circle die from the Stylish Shapes Dies set, cut center of card front toward the top and sides evenly. Run through the Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine a couple of times, then flip over and position the circle die over the almost cut through area and run through the machine again. This will completely cut through the card front.
4. Score the Basic White 5-1/4” x 8” card stock at 2”, 4”, and 6”. Score on two score lines in the same direction and the last score line in the opposite direction. Attach the Snowflake Splendor 5-3/8” x 1-7/8” DSP pieces to the two center folds. Using liquid glue, apply to the fold that is folded in the opposite direction of the other two folds and attach to inside of the card to the right side, lining up evenly to the 3 sides of the card. See the open card above.
5. Using the 2-5/8” die from the Stylish Shapes Dies set, cut out the Azure Afternoon 2-1/2” x 2-1/2” card stock. Next, fold the insert of card flat and close card front. Part of the white from the insert and part of the DSP will show through the circle you cut on card front. Using liquid glue, attach just on the fold to the right on the DSP side. Attach the circle you just cut out ensuring even placement.
6. Open card and with the insert still flat, add liquid glue on the white area around the left side of the circle. Then close the card front and evenly flatten and rub the front to ensure the glue has set. Then open the card and it should look like the picture above.
7. Cut out the 2nd piece of Azure Afternoon using the 2nd smallest circle die from the Everyday Details dies set. Attach to the circle already on the card. Next, using the largest star die from the Starlight Thinlits Dies set, cut out the White Glimmer Paper. Attach to the center of the circles on the card using mini dimensionals.
8. Stamp verse from the Star of Light stamp set and the Azure Afternoon stamp pad, stamp image onto the Basic White 2-1/2” x 1” card stock. Then cut out using the smallest rectangle die from the Everyday Details Dies set. Attach to card front using dimensionals.
9. Cover one word of the Merry Christmas stamp from the Star of Light stamp set using a piece of scotch tape. Ink up using the Azure Afternoon stamp pad. Remove the tape and stamp onto the Basic White insert on the right side shown above. Clean the stamp and repeat for the other word.
10. Attach a Rhinestone to the center of the star on the card front and one on the label. You are now done!!
