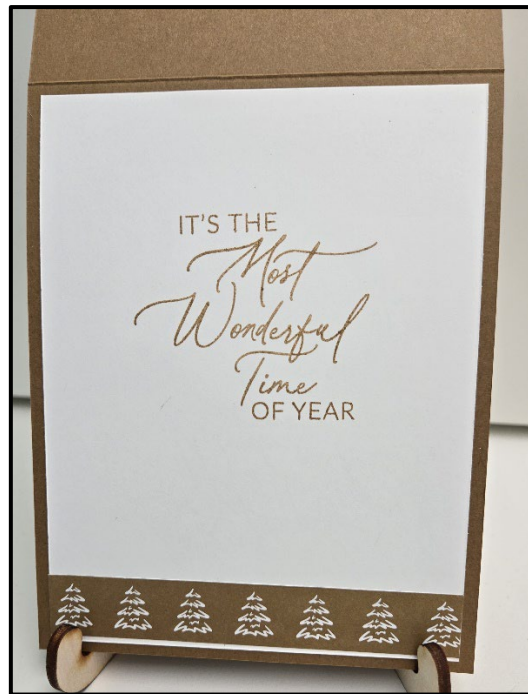


Winter Wishes



Card Stock:

Pecan Pie – 4-1/4” x 11”

Basic White – 5-1/4” x 4” (Cut 2)

Sentimental Christmas DSP – 5-1/8” x 3-7/8”

Basic White – 1-1/2” x 4-1/4”

Iconic Celebrations DSP – 1-3/8” x 4-1/4”

Basic White – 3” x 3” (To Die Cut)

Iconic Celebrations DSP – 1/2” x 4” (Inside)

Pecan Pie Scrap

Stamp Sets:

Greetings of the Season

Christmas Labels

Ink:

Pecan Pie Stampin’ Pad

VersaMark Stamp Pad

White Embossing Powder

Supplies/Accessories:

Christmas Labels Dies

Petal Pink & White 1/4” Diagonal Trim

Pecan Pie & Clear Ribbioned Dots

Stampin’ Dimensionals

Mini Glue Dots

Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine

Heat Tool

Instructions:

1. Score and fold Pecan Pie 4-1/4” x 11” card stock at 5-1/2”
2. Attach the Sentimental Christmas 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” to the Basic White 5-1/4” x 4”. Then attach the Iconic Celebrations 1-3/8” x 4-1/4” DSP to the Basic White 1-1/2” x 4-1/4” card stock. Lay this piece on the Sentimental Christmas assembled piece at an angle as shown above (don’t attach yet) and trim the ends even with the Basic White. Next, attach a length of the white diagonal ribbon onto the Iconic Celebrations assembled and trimmed piece and attach to the card as shown above.
3. Using the label from the Christmas Labels Dies set, cut out the Basic White 3” x 3”. Next, stamp verse from the Christmas Labels stamp set using VersaMark stamp pad onto the Pecan Pie scrap. Heat emboss using White embossing powder and heat tool. Using the same label die, cut out this piece ensuring the verse is centered. Trim the sides and attach to the Basic White label. Attach to card front as shown above using dimensionals.
4. Tie a bow from another length of the white diagonal ribbon and attach to ribbon on card front using a mini glue dot.
5. Stamp a verse from the Greetings of the Season stamp set onto the 2nd piece of Basic White 5-1/4” x 4” card stock using the Pecan Pie stamp pad. Attach the Iconic Celebrations 1/2” x 4” DSP to the bottom of this piece and attach to inside of card. You are now done!!
