

Perennial Dogwood



Card Stock:

Basic White Thick – 4-1/4” x 11”
Basic White – 5-1/4” x 4”
Basic White – 3-1/2” x 4-3/4” (to die cut)
Old Olive – 3” x 4-1/4”
Basic White – 2-7/8” x 4-1/8”
Old Olive – 4-1/4” x 5-1/2” (Inside, to die cut)
Basic White – 3-1/2” x 4-3/4” (Inside)

Stamp Sets:

Detailed Dogwood
Dainty Delight

Ink:

Tuxedo Black Memento Stamp Pad
Fresh Freesia Stampin’ Pad

Blender Pens:

Light & Dark Old Olive
Light & Dark Fresh Freesia
Dark Lemon Lolly

Supplies/Accessories:

Perennial Postage Dies
Timeworn Type 3D Embossing Folder
Tinsel Gems Three-Pack
Brushed Brass Butterflies
Stampin’ Dimensionals
Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine

Instructions:

1. Score and fold the Basic White Thick 4-1/4” x 11” card stock at 5-1/2” to form card size of 5-1/2” x 4-1/4”.
2. Emboss the Basic White 5-1/4” x 4” card stock using the Timeworn Type 3D Embossing Folder. Attach to card front.
3. Using the 2nd largest die from the Perennial Postage Dies set, cut out the Basic White 3-1/2” x 4-3/4” card stock. This will form a piece 3-1/4” x 4-1/2” in size. Attach the Old Olive 3” x 4-1/4” card stock to this piece.
4. Stamp the large flowers from the Detailed Dogwood stamp set onto the Basic White 2-7/8” x 4-1/8” card stock using the Memento stamp pad. Then color in using the above listed Blender Pens or colors of your choice.
5. Stamp verse from the Dainty Delight stamp set onto the stamped piece from step 4 using the Memento Stamp pad. Attach to the assembled piece from step 3. Attach to card front using dimensionals.
6. Using the largest die from the Perennial Postage Dies set, cut out the Old Olive 4-1/4” x 5-1/2” card stock. This will make a finished piece 3-3/4” x 5” in size. Attach to inside of card.
7. Using the polka dot stamp from the Detailed Dogwood stamp set and the Fresh Freesia stamp pad, stamp image onto the Basic White 3-1/2” x 4-3/4” card stock and attach to inside of card.
8. Attach Tinsel Gems and Brass Butterflies to front of card as shown above. You are now done!
