Basic Beige – 4-1/4" x 11"

Early Espresso:

5-1/4" x 4"

2-1/2" x 4"

Loveliest Tree Dies

Adhesive Backed Metallic Gems

Stampin' Dimensionals

Tear & Tape Adhesive or Liquid Glue

Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

Instructions:

1. Score the Basic Beige 4-1/4" x 11" card stock at 2-3/4" and 5-1/2" on the 11" side. Trim off 1" from the side where you scored at 2-3/4". This will form the gift card pocket. Fold on the score lines in the same direction.
2. Attach the Early Espresso 5-1/4" x 4" card stock to inside of card. Attach the Country Woods 2-5/8" x 3-7/8" DSP to the right side of the Early Espresso. Next, stamp Basic White 2-1/2" x 3-7/8" card stock using a verse from The Right Words and Early Espresso stamp pad. Attach to the left of the DSP as shown above.
3. Attach the Early Espresso 2-1/2" x 4" card stock to the front of card on the 2-3/4" section closest to the fold. Next, attach the Country Woods 2-3/8" x 3-7/8" DSP to the Early Espresso.
4. Attach the Early Espresso 1-1/2" x 4" card stock to the 1-3/4" section that will form the gift card pocket. Then attach the Country Woods 1-3/8" x 3-7/8" DSP to the Early Espresso. Next, using the Tear & Tape or liquid glue attach the GC pocket sides.
5. Stamp the Happy Birthday from The Right Words stamp set onto the bottom right of the Country Woods 4" x 2-3/4" DSP using the Early Espresso stamp pad. Attach to the Early Espresso 4-1/4" x 2-7/8" card stock. Attach to the card front only using adhesive on the left side of this piece.
6. Using the large tree from the Loveliest Tree stamp set, stamp image onto the Basic White scrap using Garden Green stamp pad. Next, color in base of tree using the Pecan Pie marker. You'll need to go over it several times and wipe off ink as you go. Cut out using the Coordinating die from the Loveliest Tree Dies set. Attach to the center of the piece on the card front using dimensionals.
7. Randomly attach the metallic Gems to card front and you are now done!!
