Instructions:

- 1. Score and fold Petal Pink 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" on the 8-1/2" side at 4-1/4".
- 2. Attach the Cajun Craze 5-1/4" x 4" card stocks, one on the card front and one inside of card.
- **3**. Using the Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder, emboss the Petal Pink 3-7/8" x 5-1/8" card stock. Attach to card front.
- **4**. Attach the Favored Flowers 2" x 5" DSP to the Cajun Craze 2-1/8" x 5-1/8" card stock. Attach to card front using dimensionals as shown above.
- **5**. Using two flowers of choice from the Quiet Meadows Dies set, cut from Basic White scraps. Attach to the card front using liquid glue as shown above.
- **6**. Stamp a piece of Basic White scrap with the word love from the Quiet Meadow stamp set using the Cajun Craze stamp pad. Cut out using the tag die from the Meadow Dies set. Next, cut another tag from the Cajun Craze scrap. Set aside until next step.
- **7**. Loop linen twine around your fingers to form a triple loop bow. Attach the labels from step 6, then attach to card front using a mini glue dot.
- 8. Attach several Gems to card front.
- **9.** Stamp the Basic White 3-7/8" x 5-1/8" card stock using the Petal Pink stamp pad and the dotty stamp from the Quiet Meadow stamp set. Next, over the dotty image, stamp verse of choice from the same stamp set using the Cajun Craze stamp pad. Attach the Favored Flowers $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3-7/8" DSP to the bottom on the piece. Then attach to inside of card and you are now done.
