

Notes of Spring



Card Stock:

Basic Black – 4-1/4” x 11”
Basic White – 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” (Cut 2)
Wood Grain Wonders DSP – 5” x 3-3/4”
Wood Grain Wonders DSP – 4-7/8” x 3-5/8”
Pecan Pie – 5-1/4” x 4” (Inside)
Wood Grain Wonders DSP – 4-7/8” x 1/2” (Inside)
Basic White Scraps

Stamp Set:

Notes of Spring

Ink:

Early Espresso Stampin’ Pad
Pecan Pie Stampin’ Pad

Supplies/Accessories:

Stylish Shapes Dies
Neutral Matte Dots
Multipurpose Liquid Glue
Stampin’ Dimensionals
Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine
Paper Snips

Instructions:

1. Score and fold the Basic Black 4-1/4” x 11” on the long side at 5-1/2”.
2. Attach one Basic White 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” card stock to the front of the card.
3. Attach the Wood Grain Wonders 5” x 3-3/4” DSP to the card front.
4. Using the 2-1/8” circle die from the Stylish Shapes Dies set, cut the Wood Grain Wonder 4-7/8” x 3-5/8” DSP about 2/3 of the way. Attach to the card front.
5. Stamp the verse from the Notes of Spring stamp set onto the Basic White 3-1/8” x 1/2” card stock using the Early Espresso stamp pad. Angle cut the right end of the label, then attach on the bottom of the circle on card front as shown above.
6. Stamp two of the larger grasses from the Notes of Spring stamp set onto a Basic White scrap using the Early Espresso stamp pad. Fussy cut these two stamped images out. Using liquid glue, attach to the left of the circle on card front, over the left of the label as shown above.
7. Stamp the deer from the Notes of Spring stamp set onto a Basic White scrap using the Early Espresso stamp pad. Then using the coordinating filler stamp from the same stamp set and the Pecan Pie stamp pad, stamp image off once then stamp over the deer image. Fussy cut the deer out. Attach over the grass on card front using dimensionals as shown above.
8. Attach a couple Matte dots to the circle.
9. If desired, stamp the same deer image to the second Basic White 5-1/8” x 3-7/8” card stock as you did for the card front. Then attach the Wood Grain Wonders 3-7/8” x 1/2” DSP just under the deer. You are now done!!
